Location: Toronto, Canada; Havana and Santiago de Cuba, Cuba
Canada: May 28-1 June, 2008; Cuba: June 1-8, 2008
Visit to Cuba may be extended from June 8-12
CLE credit is not available for the Cuba portion of trip

(The meeting begins in Toronto, Canada on May 28, 2008. NBA delegates can make individual arrangements through the travel agency from their home base to Toronto, Canada and arrive back on June 8, 2008.)
