A copy of your last Report Card/Progress Report. Official Transcript not required.

Parent/Guardian evidence of income and number of dependents, if you are seeking tuition assistance

Evidence of family income and dependents must be confirmed by submitting the most recently filed tax return; W-2; pay stub; or other document/letter confirming income OR lack of income.

Please black out all Social Security Numbers; Documents will be immediately shredded. If you do not wish to disclose income, a fee of \$1,400 is required.
