The 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual NBA Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony will be held on Friday, August 7, 2009, during the NBA's 84<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention in San Diego, California.

**The NBA Hall of Fame honors lawyers who have been licensed to practice law for forty years or more, and who have made significant contributions to the cause of justice.**

It is appropriate to pause and honor those whose courage, intellectual accomplishments, professional achievements and community contributions deserve the highest recognition.

Nominations for the 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual NBA Hall of Fame, must include:

- a biographical resume highlighting the nominee's accomplishments and contributions;
- one color or black and white photograph (clear face view - original photographs only);
- the names of three references;
- a statement from a state bar or highest court evidencing that the nominee is in good standing with the bar.
